

Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority (CICA)

Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority (CICA) is a government funded organisation which may provide compensation for families bereaved by crime.

You might be able to claim compensation if:

- you were injured
- a close relative died
- you saw the crime happen to 'a loved one' (or were there immediately afterwards)
- you paid for the funeral of a person who died

You usually have to claim within 2 years of the crime and the crime must be reported to the police before you apply.

It does not cost anything to apply.
